We do use hand sanitizer in all the classes and parents may send a bottle of sanitizer that can also be used in the classroom.

Learners may bring their grey water to school every Wednesday. We will return bottles home after we have used the water.

CLOTHING POLICY

Please note that no characters (Batman, Hulk,..) or fantasy clothing may be worn. For more information check our uniform policy in the Parent Handbook.

CLASS TIME

All children should be in their classes **no later than 7:55am**. The school opens for early drop off at 7:00am, the children go to their classes at 7:30am and start work as soon as they go into their classrooms. They all have a three-hour work period and it is important that they are on time always.

SCHOOL GATE

For security purposes, the main gate may **NOT** be left open at any time.

SICK CHILDREN

Please call the office before 8:30 am if your child is sick. Please let us know what illness your child has especially if it is contagious so we can notify the other parents.

By law, we are not allowed to administer medicines to your child; if your child is on antibiotics they should be at home resting.

STOP AND DROP/CAR PARK

The car park is a one-way system; please follow the correct way in and out of the car park.

We have three members of staff on duty to open the car door so that your child can walk with his/her schoolbag into the school safely.

Please remember to drive slowly in the car park as children are sometimes climbing out of cars from both sides of a car.

Please remember not to park in front of the school gate as this will cause a long line of traffic into the street. This is especially for Primary parents collecting at 14:00.

<u>All</u> preschool and primary children must use the stop and drop system at our school.

VISITORS

Please report to the office immediately, if your child needs to go to an appointment the secretary will fetch the child from the class.

COMMUNICATION

Please do not Whatsapp any of the staff during school time as they are not allowed to keep their cell phones on during the school day. All communication should be done through the office only, even if there is an urgent message.
